THE ODD RED BUNCH

From the sweet/savoury cherry aromas of the Sangiovese to the massive black fruits of the Zinfandels and finally the violet/blackberry notes of the Petit Verdot. These are indeed the 'ODD BUNCH', and make for some truly interesting drinking experiences.
